Sparkling

Prosecco Frizzante Adalina NV (Veneto, Italy)

£37.50

Crisp, clean and well-balanced sparkling wine with fruity nose and soft refreshing character on the palate

Prosecco Spumante Biodynamic (Veneto, Italy)

£43.00

Fresh and fruity with hints of golden apple and citrus flavours brought together by fine, lively bubbles and a long ripe finish. The first ever organic Prosecco producer

Bolney Brut NV (West Sussex, England)

£90.00

Bolney, create wines in the traditional method (method champenoise) to create a sparkling wine of the highest standard

Bolney Bubbly Rose (West Sussex, England)

£89.50

Made in traditional method, with notes of red berries including redcurrant, red cherry & strawberry, brought together with a hint of almonds.

Champagne Dericbourg Cuvée de Reserve Brut (Champagne, France)

£98.50

Fresh green apples, lemon sherbet and white flowers leap from the glass. Underneath there's support from hints of toast and brioche and a lovely pithiness. Dry, refreshing and focused with notes of citrus

Noughty Sparkling Chardonnay (Rhone, Germany) 0%

£33.00

Alcohol free option. Elegant pale colour with a crisp and ripe apple scent accompanied by a touch of sweetness. Subtle flavours with a lingering finish

White Wine

Boca a Boca White (Galicia, Spain) £26.50

Crisp, dry with juicy citrus and green apple flavours.

Spier Chenin Blanc (Stellenbosch, South Africa) £28.50

A delicate gold colour has plenty to offer quince, citrus and stone fruits but a few notes. Gloriously juicy on the palate with a refreshing & zesty finish.

Arbos Pinot Grigio Organic (Sicily, Italy) £30.50

This wine is made from organically grown grapes, using free-run juice and indigenous yeast only. Fresh aromas of apple and pear with a hint of citrus fruit that fades into the floral finish.

Maison de la Paix Viognier (Languedoc, France) £32.00

This beautiful 100% Viognier has a smooth, rich texture and good length. On the palate, the wine shows tropical fruits which give way to notes of peach, apricot and cool, clean minerality.

Sotherton Chardonnay (South Australia, Australia) £33.00

Ripe citrus and apple flavours with a refreshing crisp finish.

Gavi Guido Matteo (Piedmonte, Italy) £41.00

Fresh and delicious stone fruit, floral notes and a crisp finish.

Bolney Estate Pinot Gris (West Sussex, England) £52.00

Classic Chablis flavours of green apples and ripe, zippy citrus fruits in this textbook example from Louis Robin, all complemented by a creamy texture and an ever so slightly honeyed note.

Lychgate Bacchus (West Sussex, England) £57.00

Referred to as 'England's Sauvignon Blanc', fragrant wine with aromas of ripe green apple & gooseberry

Louis Robin Chablis (Burgundy, France) £59.00

Classic Chablis flavours of green apples and ripe, zippy citrus fruits with a creamy texture.





Red Wine

Boca a Boca Red (Galicia, Spain)	£26.50
Rich and concentrated red wine, with flavours of ripe blackberry & plum.	
Maison de la Paix Carignan (Pays D'Oc, France)	£29.00
A great value southern French red, with concentrated flavours from old vines. Lush and spicy with red cherries, raspberry and plum, followed by a smooth finish with a touch of spice.	
Les Peyrautins Pinot Noir (Pays d'Oc, France)	£32.50
Cherry red, raspberry and strawberry hints on the nose, which carry through to the palate with notes of violet and a touch of spice.	
Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Organic (Abruzzo, Italy)	£33.00
Purple ruby red wine with an intense bouquet of red berry fruits and sour cherry. Full, harmonic and pleasantly tannic on the palate.	
Sotherton Shiraz (South Australia, Australia)	£34.00
Strong plum and blackberry flavours, with a smooth, rounded finish.	
Laztana Reserva Rioja (Rioja, Spain)	£38.50
Sweet ripe fruit and delicate aromas of smokiness on the nose are followed by a rich palate of cherries, plums, blackberries and vanilla. Full-bodied wine with fresh and fruity finish.	
Spier Savanha Merlot (Western Cape, South Africa)	£43.00
Fruit driven wine filled with plum and raspberry aromas and a hint of spice.	
Bolney Estate Pinot Noir (West Sussex, England)	£58.00
Glorious flavours of blackcurrant, leading into a ripe, fresh fig with notes of dark cherry & white pepper.	
Château du Puy, Montagne-St. Emilion (Bordeaux, France)	£59.00
Fresh plum and blackberry on the nose with a hint of spice. Silky smooth tannins and a balanced finish	

Rose Wine

Three Choirs Rose (Gloucestershire, England)

£45.50

A delicious rose full of strawberry and summer fruit aromas, on the palate its incredibly fresh with hints of cherry and strawberries and cream.

Lychgate Rose (West Sussex, England)

£47.00

An expressive wine with stylish summer flavours of raspberry pomegranate and a hint of fresh strawberries and cream.
